STEAM Activities

Hands-on STEAM activities are designed to make ALL students get excited about the world around them.

Sample programs include: Drones, Oceanic Exploration, Claymation, Makey Makey, Green Screen, Genetics, Famous Architecture Around the World, Plants and Seeds and Unleash Your Wild Side.

Literacy Courses

Students will participate in small groups specifically designed to develop literacy skills and engage students in their learning.
